### INGREDIENTS

- Set Tonality & Color
- Mix in Some Sunshine
- Stir in Dynamic Contrast
- Garnish with a Vintage Filter
- Modify to Taste

### INSTRUCTIONS

**Step 1.** Launch ON1 Photo RAW/ 2019 and browse to where the practice files you downloaded are stored. Select practice file "IMG\_0588.jpg" and then choose the Edit module icon.

**Step 2.** Inside the Develop tab, set Tone & Color. Decrease exposure to -0.85 to darken and remove some blown out areas.

**Step 3.** Increase contrast to 12 to add contrast and make the photo pop a bit.

**Step 4.** Increase midtones to 13 to brighten the photo a little.

**Step 5.** Increase shadows to 20 to reveal darker underlying tones.

**Step 6.** Decrease blacks to -8 to add contrast and detail.

**Step 7.** Increase temperature to 6000 to bring in warm colors and bring out the forest's green tones.

**Step 8.** In the Effects tab, choose Add Filter. Select a Sunshine filter.

**Step 9.** Choose the Strong preset style.

**Step 10.** Select Add Filter and choose a Dynamic Contrast Filter.

\*I just used the preset style which is Natural but you could modify the Small slider to bring out detail and textures in the trees.

**Step 11.** Select Add Filter and choose a Vintage filter.

**Step 12.** In the Color drop down menu, choose the "Split Pea" preset style.

**Step 13.** Lower the opacity to 16 to blend, this will add a nice boost of color and midtones to garnish.
