INGREDIENTS

- Set Tone & Color
- A Dash of Split Tone to Style
- Some Dynamic Contrast for Detail
- A Color Enhancer
- Mix in Curves for a Cinematic Look
- Local Adjustment to Top Off

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1. Launch ON1 Photo RAW 2019 and browse to where the practice files you downloaded are stored. Select practice file IMG_0421.jpg and then choose the Edit module icon.

Step 2. Inside the Develop tab set the tonality and color. Increase contrast to 13 to make the photo pop a bit.

Step 3. Pull up on the midtones slider to 13 to bring out mid-tone details.

Step 4. Increase the shadows to 16 to reveal darker areas in the photo.

Step 5. Decrease the blacks slider to -5 to add a little more contrast and detail.

Step 6. Increase the temperature to 7500 to warm the photo up and bring in warmer colors.

Step 7. In the Effects tab, select Add Filter. Add a Dynamic Contrast Filter to apply some nice detail to the scene.

Step 8. Choose Add Filter and then select Sunshine. Use the Strong preset style to give the photo a bright and contrasted look.

Step 9. Select Add Filter and then choose the Photo Filter. Select the 85 preset style to add in some dreamy red to the scene. Use the opacity slider to pull back on the filter to around 26 or to taste.

Step 10. Add another filter and add a Glow filter. Choose the Darker preset style option.**Step 11.** Grab your Masking Bug by hitting "m" on your keyboard. Drop the Masking Bug gradient onto the scene. Using the larger circle, click and drag the gradient around to remove the Glow filter from the top of the mountain and give the reflection a dreamy and dark glow.
