INGREDIENTS

- Set Tone & Color
- Increase Exposure, Shadows, and Contrast • Add a Color Enhancer
- Top it off with a Big Softy Vignette

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1. Launch ON1 Photo RAW 2019 and browse to where the practice files you downloaded are stored. Select practice file 0J9A9506.jpg and then choose the Edit module icon.

Step 2. In the Develop tab set your tonality and color. Increase exposure to 0.8 to brighten the photo but not to overexpose.

Step 3. Increase your shadows slider to 21 to pull out and reveal darker tones.

Step 4. To add in some contrast and make the photo pop, I pulled back on the blacks slider to -13.

Step 5. Increase your structure to 22. This will bring in detail and make sure everything is sharp when we start applying filters.

Step 6. To bring in some warmer tones, pull up on the temperature slider to 10. This will help bring our greens and yellows to life.

Step 7. From the Effects tab choose Add a Filter then select Color Enhancer. Choose the Fall preset style. This will increase fall colors like yellows and greens so it's perfect for this image. Pull back on the opacity slider to taste and to maintain the true colors in the scene without over-saturating.

Step 8. Choose Add a Filter and select the Vignette filter. I chose big softy because of it's high feathering and mellow look. You can also reduce the opacity on this filter if the Vignette a little stronger than you like.
